The L.E. Shore Memorial Library and the Arts Advisory Council proudly welcomes Alice Cowan who will be exhibiting her water colour paintings for the month of February. The opening reception with the artist in attendance will be held on Saturday, February 4 from 2:00-5:00pm

The exhibit features a wide range of impeccably detailed water colour paintings, spanning from the onset of Cowan's artistic career in the early 1980's. Alice Cowan will be sitting the gallery on the weekends throughout the month of February.

Alice Cowan began her career as a paste-up artist in a large commercial art studio and eventually became a lettering artist, then a graphic designer '*everything was done by hand, it was great fun, and I learned skills and shortcuts that I use today in water colour painting*'. Cowan and her family moved to the Blue Mountains area in 1989.

Alice Cowan's art exhibit will be showing from February 4 to February 29th, during regular library hours. The L.E. Shore Library is open Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 10am until 8 p.m., Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 10 am until 5 pm and Sundays from 12 until 4pm.
