QUICK START GUIDE

You can browse, checkout and download popular audiobooks and ebooks from our website.

To use this service you need ...

- A valid library card
- An Internet connection
- A computer or device that meets the system requirements for the type(s) of materials you wish to download.

What you should know

Prior to downloading an audiobook or ebook for the first time, you will need to install some free software: OverDrive Media Console (for audiobooks) and Adobe Digital Editions (for eBooks).



Getting started

1. Locate and click the OverDrive link at: thebluemountainslibrary.ca/eBooks.html
2. The first time you visit OverDrive's Ontario Library Service Download Centre, a help page will open to introduce you to the service.
3. At the bottom left of the page, there are links to download the free digital software.

For ebooks: Adobe Digital Editions
For audiobooks: OverDrive Media Console
4. There are extensive instructions and help documents on the digital software pages.
5. You don't have to be logged in to browse for ebooks and audiobooks, but it helps!

Step 1: Login

1. Click on the **Login** link at the top of the page.
2. Choose **Libraries A-E**, and then select **The Blue Mountains Public Library**.
3. Enter your library card number, which is the entire 14-digit number as it appears on your card: E.g. 23681000012345
4. Enter the last four digits of your phone number as your PIN.
5. If you have overdues or your card has been suspended at the Library, you will not be able to login.

Step 2: Browse

1. To the left of the screen, you can search by title, subject and keyword or browse by category.
2. Icons below each title indicate whether it is an ebook or audiobook and what devices you can download it to.
3. A limited number of copies (or licenses) are available for loan.
4. If a title is available to borrow, there will be a link to **Add to cart**. If the title is checked out by another patron, there will be a link to **Place a hold**.
5. If you place a hold, enter your email address and you will be notified when the title is ready for downloading.

Step 3: Check Out

1. Click **Add to cart** to choose a title. After selecting each title, you may **Continue Browsing** or **Proceed to Checkout**.
2. Choose a lending period for each title: 7 or 14 days and **Confirm Checkout**.

Step 4: Download

1. Your titles are now available for download.
2. **Audiobooks:** The download button will launch the OverDrive Media Console and prompt you to select which parts of the book you wish to download. Each part is about one hour of listening. If your Internet connection is slow, you may want to download one part at a time.
3. Once downloaded, titles may be enjoyed on your computer and many can be transferred to a portable device or discs. Caution: one audiobook may be many CDs!
4. **eBooks:** Downloading ebooks differs with different devices and ereaders.
5. The Library has detailed instructions on downloading ebooks to iPads, Kobo and Sony eReaders. Ask at the Library or download these instructions at:
