

Fifty-eight contributing households, businesses and organizations provided the candy and chips they would have given out, had trick-or-treating occurred. Goldsmith's stocked us with hay bails and gourds for decoration, which will now be transported to the Community Garden for winter use. The BMPL staff quarantined the loot and packaged it for the pandemic event. More than 65 cars with over 250 ghosts, goblins, and witches drove through and collected more than 10,000 pieces of candy.

The Thirteenth Tale by Diane Setterfield A aging, reclusive author wants to finally tell the truth about her extraordinary life in this tale of gothic strangeness.

Trigger Warning: Short Fictions and Disturbances by Neil Gaiman A rich cornucopia of horror and ghosts stories, science fiction and fairy tales, fabulism and poetry that explore the realm of experience and emotion.

The Night Circus by Erin Morgenstern The circus arrives without warning. Within the black-and-white striped canvas tents is an utterly unique experience full of breathtaking amazements. It is called Le Cirque des Rêves, and it is only open at night.

The Secret History by Donna Tartt A group of clever, eccentric misfits at an elite college discover a way of thinking and living that is a world away from the humdrum existence. But when they go beyond the boundaries of normal morality they slip gradually from obsession to corruption and betrayal, and at last - inexorably - into evil.
