What is Cultural Mapping?

Cultural mapping has been defined as: "a process of collecting, recording, analyzing, and synthesizing information in order to describe the cultural resources, networks, links, and patterns of usage of a given community or group."

Cultural Mapping Mission

- To allow residents to self-identify and digitally map /document the people, places, and resources that define their community identity (and to share the stories and narratives that go with them).
- The hope is to bridge communities and connect people to resources they might not know are available "right next door".
- The other hope in running this project is to help promote tourism throughout the entire town and to bring tourism dollars to every district with the long-range goal of identifying and creating cultural districts that will bolster sustainable economic development in all areas of the town.

Cultural, Natural and Intangible Heritage (as defined by UNESCO)

Cultural Heritage: includes artefacts, monuments, a building, or group of buildings and/or sites, that have a diversity of values including symbolic, historic, artistic, aesthetic, ethnological or anthropological, scientific, and social significance.

Natural Heritage: refers to natural features, geological and physiographical formations, and areas of habitat of threatened species and natural sites of value from the point of view of science, conservation, or natural beauty.

Intangible Heritage: Traditions or living expressions inherited from our ancestors and passed on to our descendants, such as oral traditions, performing arts, social practices, rituals, festive events, knowledge, and practices concerning nature and the universe or the knowledge and skills to produce traditional crafts.
