• **Technologically Connected Hub:** BMPL was successful in receiving a Resilient Communities Fund grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation. Organizational Excellence

- Board Information Night: The Board will be presenting an information night on Nov 8th at 6:00pm for those who may be interested in applying to join the Board. Council will be appointing 6 community members and 1 Council member to sit on the Board for the 4 year cycle. - Board Recruitment Deputation: The Library Chair with the CEO made a Deputation to Council on Sept 26th on how the Board can support Council in recruiting 2022-2026 Library Board members. The Recruitment Plan was accepted. At the Oct. Board meeting two members of the outgoing Board were appointed to sit on a review committee.
