2026 Salon Show Submission Form & Contract

The Arts and Culture Council (ACC) for The Gallery at L.E. Shore is pleased to announce an open invitation, Salon Arts and Crafts exhibition. Every year the ACC hosts an open show, centered around a theme colour, where artists are invited to submit their work for inclusion. The 2026 Salon Show will open on **Saturday**, **January 31** and run through **Wednesday**, **March 4** with the theme of **Celebrating the Colour Orange**.

Important Dates

- Art Intake: on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>January 29</u>, <u>between 10am and 7pm</u>, please deliver your entry payment, submission form (this form) and artwork to The Gallery at L.E. Shore. If you cannot deliver on that day, you may contact <u>TheGallery@TheBlueMountains.ca</u> to determine if special arrangements can be made. No pieces received after this date will be accepted.
- Due to space allowances, the ACC cannot guarantee all submitted pieces will be hung but will do their best to have at least one piece represented from each applicant. After the hanging on Friday, January 30, we may need to contact you to retrieve pieces.
- Reception: artists are encouraged to attend the reception on Saturday, January 31.
- Art Pick Up (end of show): all unsold artwork must be retrieved on Thursday, March 5
 between 10am and 7pm.

Conditions

- Only 1 submission form per artist will be accepted. Submission forms are delivered on the art intake day (January 29).
- All artwork should meet the colour theme of orange. Other colours may be included, but the theme of orange should be present.
- There is a <u>\$20</u> charge for entering the show, which includes between 1 and 3 pieces. Payment is processed on art intake day (January 29).
- Our hanging crew will do their best to hang <u>all</u> your submitted pieces. The \$20 charge
 ensures that, at minimum, at least one of your submitted pieces will be hung. The exception
 to this rule is if none of your submitted pieces meet the colour criteria, in which case none
 of them will be hung. In this scenario, a full refund will be provided.
- All artwork must be available for purchase. The Gallery charges a 25% commission on all sales.
- The Gallery at L.E. Shore is not responsible for orphaned artwork. If you are not able to retrieve your pieces on March 5, please arrange to have someone come in your stead.
